

**Savitribai Phule...**

Savitribai Phule (3 January 1831 – 10 March 1897) was an Indian social reformer, educationalist, and poet from Maharashtra. She is regarded as the first female teacher of India. Along with her husband, Jyotirao Phule, she played an important role in improving women's right in India during British rule. She is regarded as the mother of Indian feminism. Phule and her husband founded the first Indian girls' school in Pune, at Bhide wada in 1848. She worked to abolish the discrimination and unfair treatment of people based on caste and gender. She is regarded as an important figure of the social reform movement in Maharashtra. Savitribai's birthdate is now celebrated as Balika Din in the whole of Maharashtra, especially in Girls Schools.

**International Yoga Day**


Concept of International Yoga Day was proposed by the respected former minister of India, Mr. Narendra Modi.

- The second International Yoga day was held in the city of Chandigarh.



## **Online Study during COVID-19**

This session saw a switch from regular classes in the school to online classes at home. As a result, education has changed dramatically whereby teaching is being done through different digital platforms.

At MAKS, teachers and students are regularly in contact through Zoom platform and WhatsApp. Regular online classes are being conducted. Apart from this videos made by the teachers themselves are being sent to students who are unable to attend the classes.

Homework is being sent in the form of PDF's. Both students and teachers have adjusted themselves to the new ways of learning & teaching.

## **Commencement of Online session:**

A timetable was prepared to conduct the Teaching learning process smoothly. Taking into consideration the power cut in our area ,the timetable was prepared in such a manner that Thursday was an Off day . The school started with the online sessions in the month of June.

## **Attendance:**

98 –99 % students attend the online sessions. Only 1-2% students who were not able to attend the online session due to network issue or some medical reasons were supported through offline medium.

## **Assessment of Learning gaps:**

During online session verbal assessment by asking questions was conducted by the teachers. The various tests assigned in the form of Google forms gave an analysis of the performance of the class and question wise mapping.
