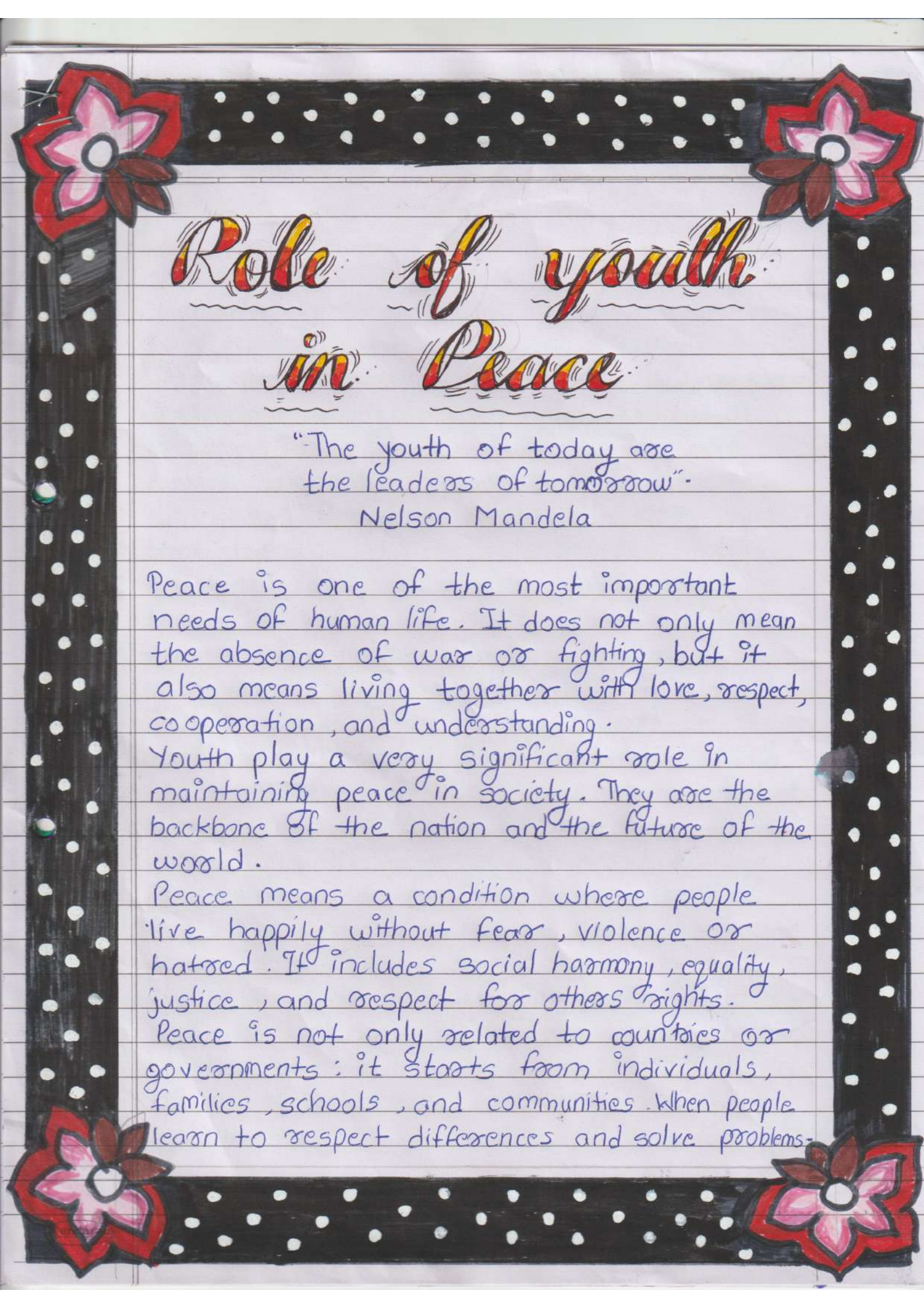




Role of youth in Peace

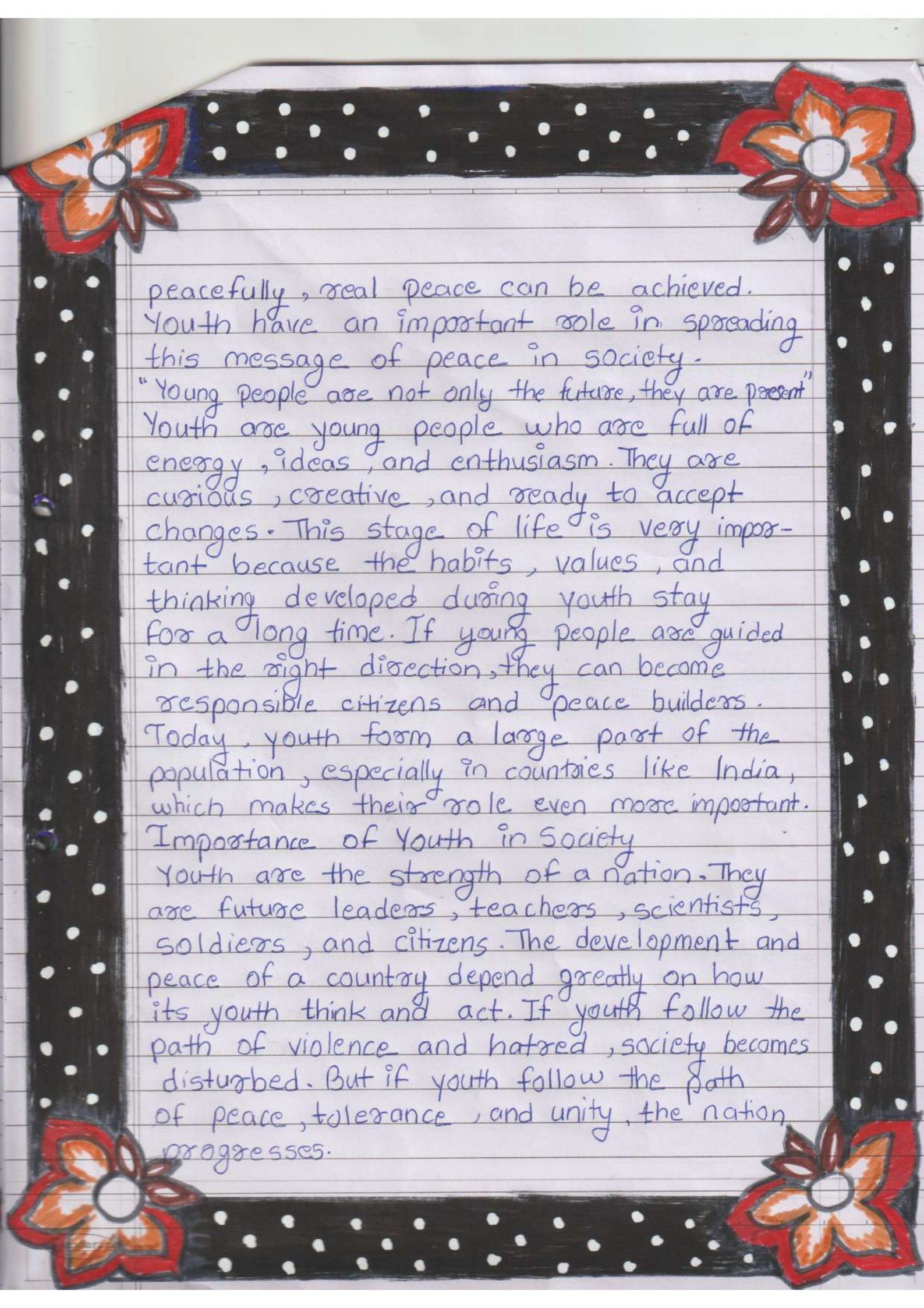

this message of peace in society.

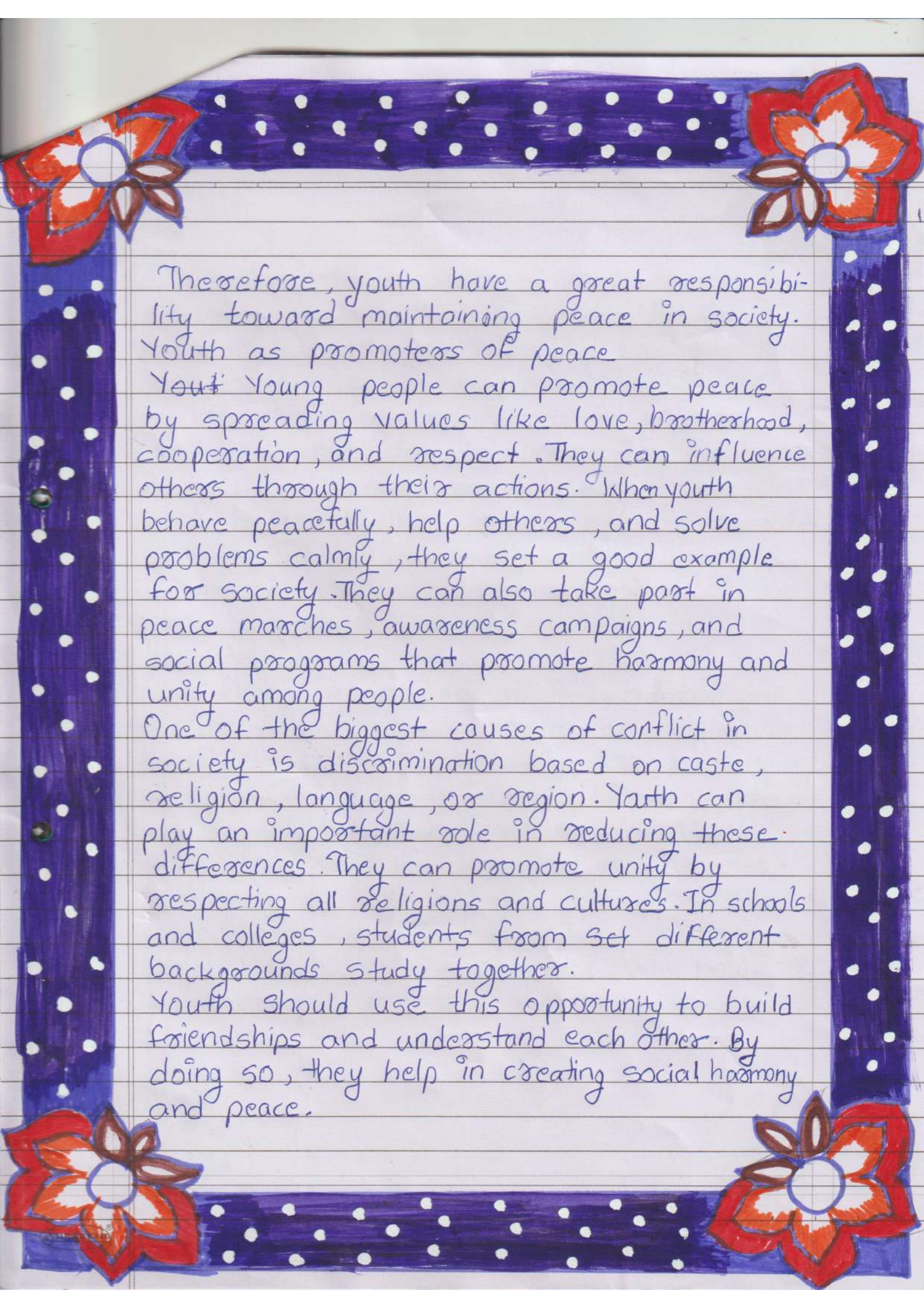

progresses.



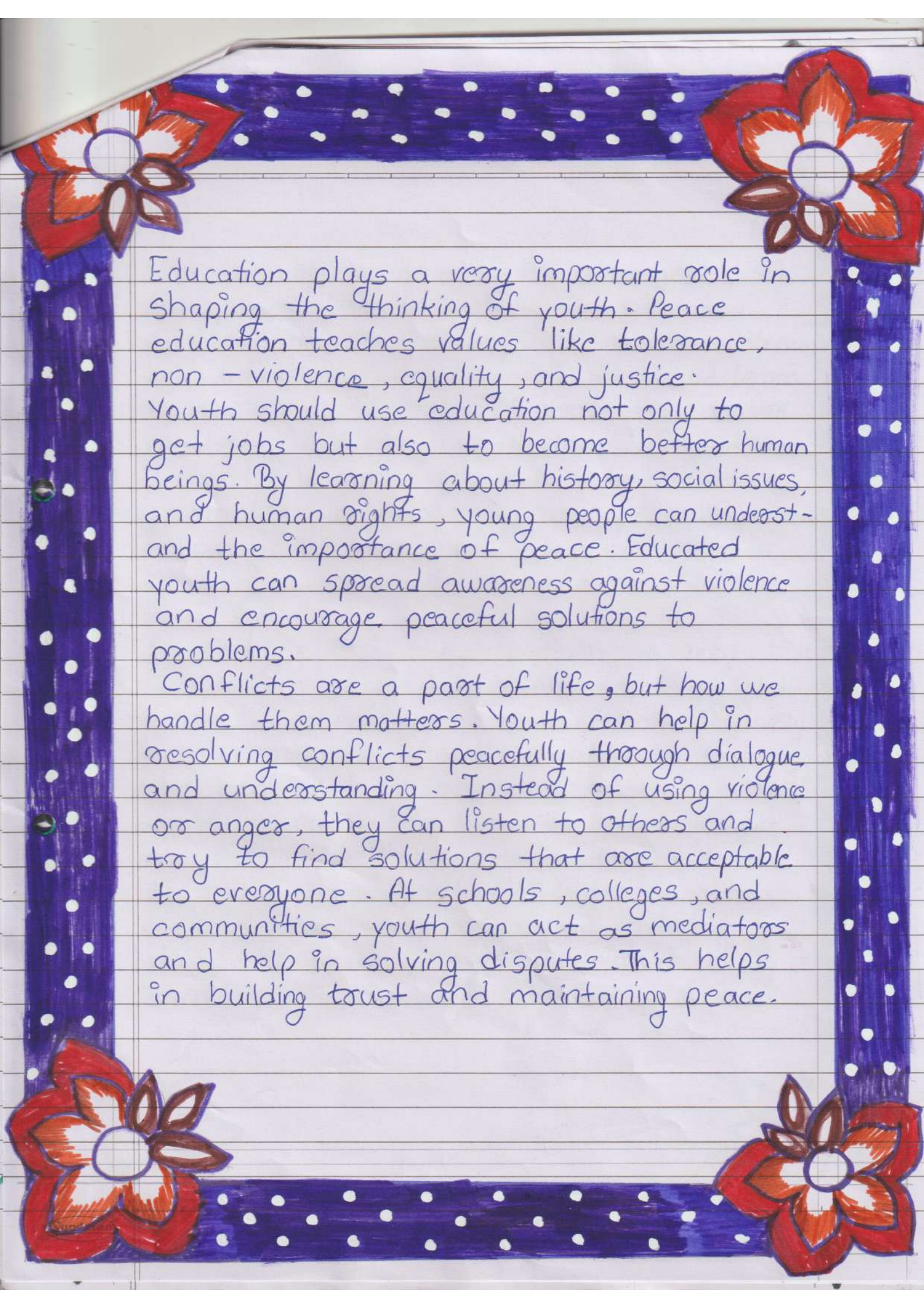
Therefore, youth have a great responsibility toward maintaining peace in society.

differences. They can promote unity by respecting all religions and cultures. In schools and colleges, students from set different backgrounds study together.

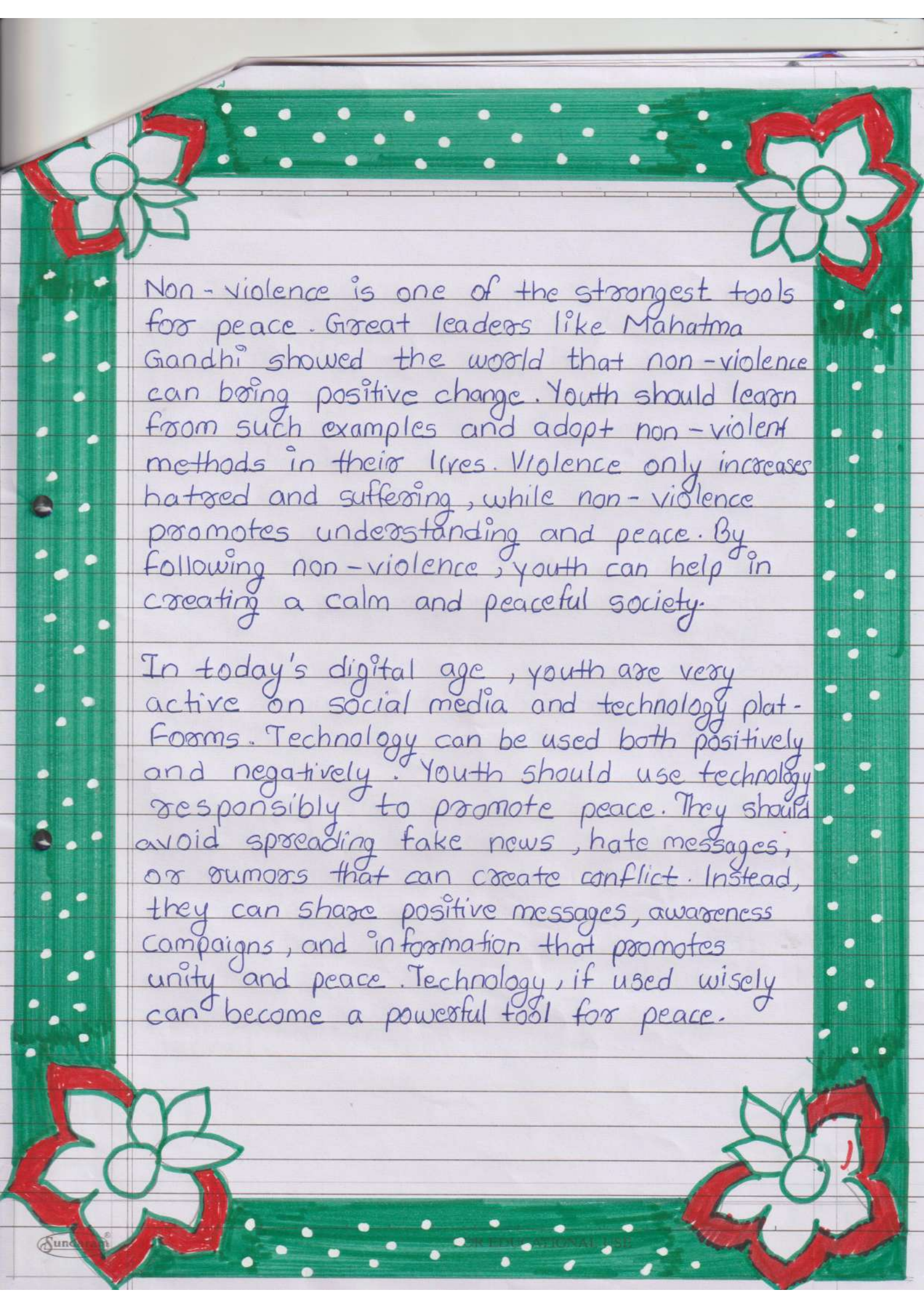
Youth should use this opportunity to build friendships and understand each other. By doing so, they help in creating social harmony and peace.



Education plays a very important role in shaping the thinking of youth. Peace education teaches values like tolerance, non-violence, equality, and justice.

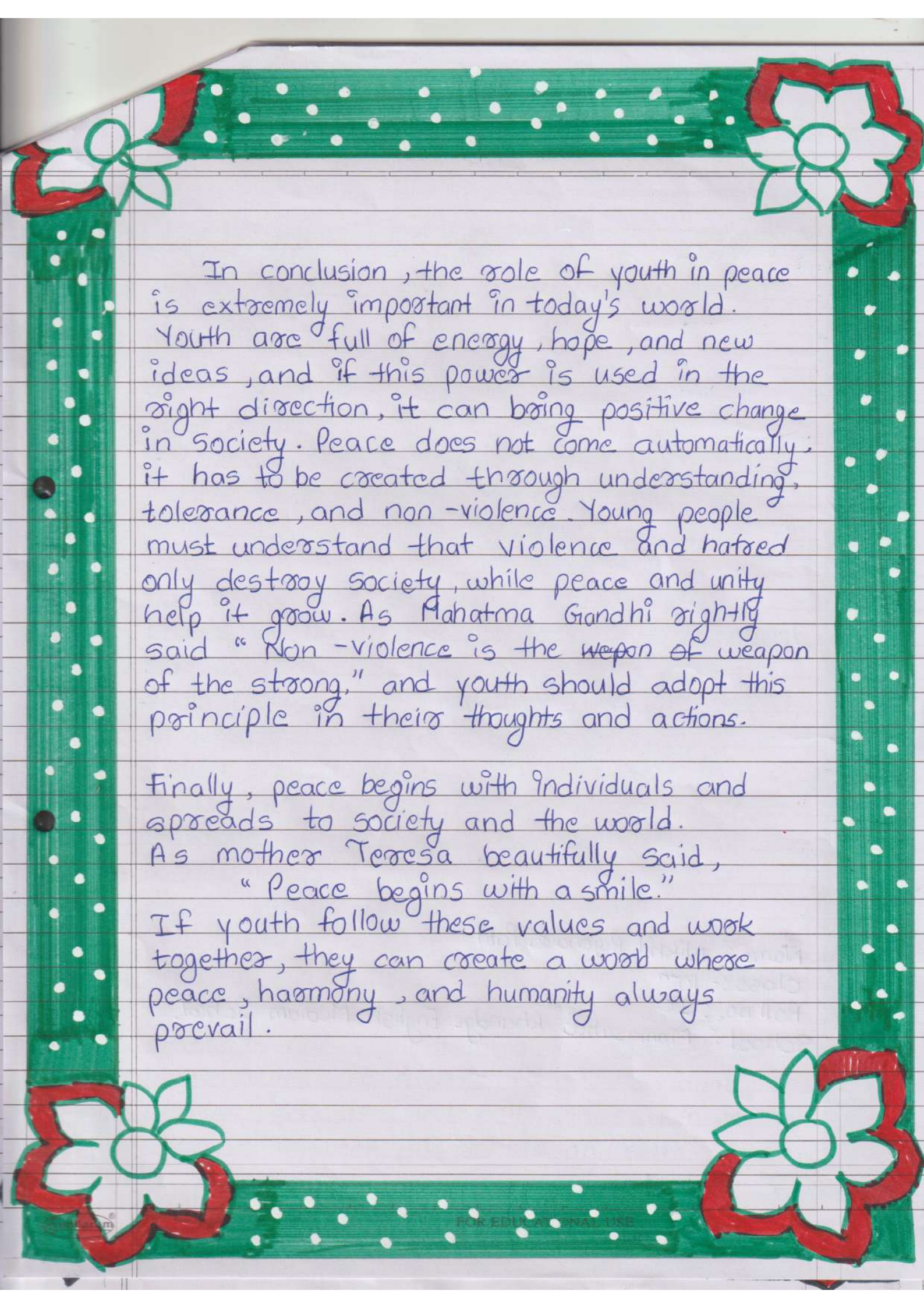
